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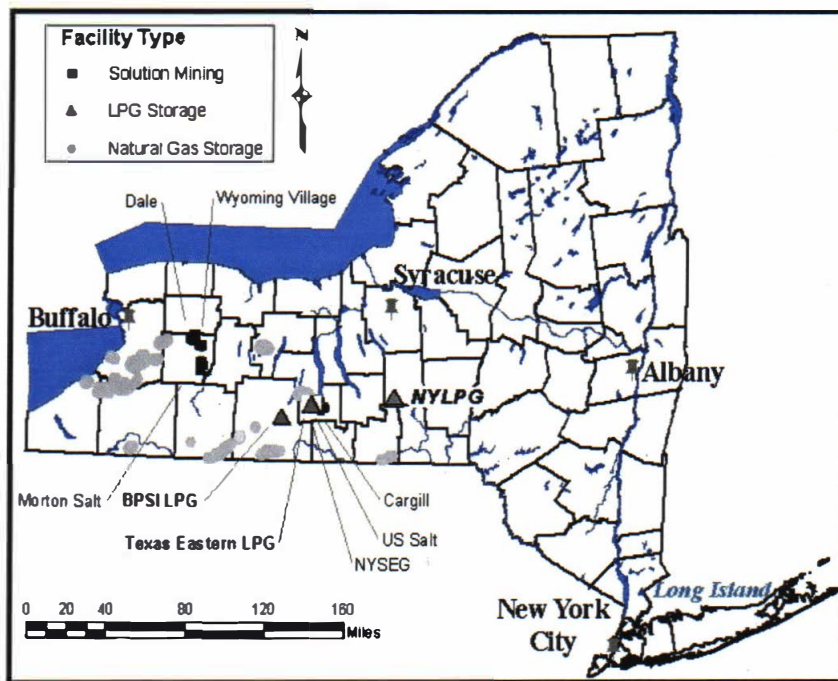

Current Operation***

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Location

New York LP Gas Storage, Inc. (“NYLPG”), an underground liquefied petroleum gas (“LPG”) storage facility and dispensing terminal, is located approximately fifty miles south of Syracuse, New York in the rural community of Harford, New York in Cortland County (see Figure 1). NYLPG is commonly referred to as the Harford Mills facility or terminal despite it not being within Harford Mills proper. The locations of Bath Petroleum Storage Inc. (“BPSI”) and TE Products Pipeline Company (“Texas Eastern” or “TEPPCO”), the only other underground LPG storage facilities in the New York State, are also shown in Figure 1.



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
